What does the verb **estar** mean?  
There is another word in Spanish that means the same.

**ser** -- to be

soy	somos
eres	sois
es	son



Ser is more permanent than estar. While estar tells about where we are or how we are feeling at the moment, ser tells about our character and other more permanent things about us.

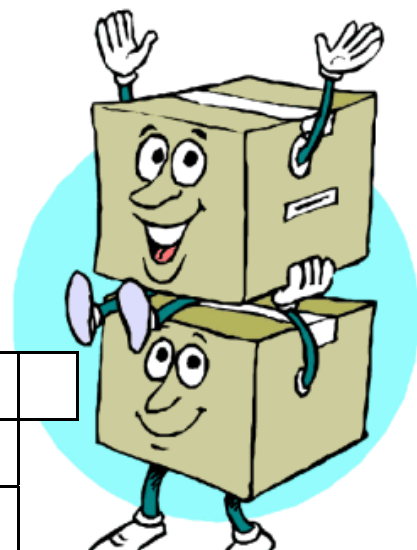

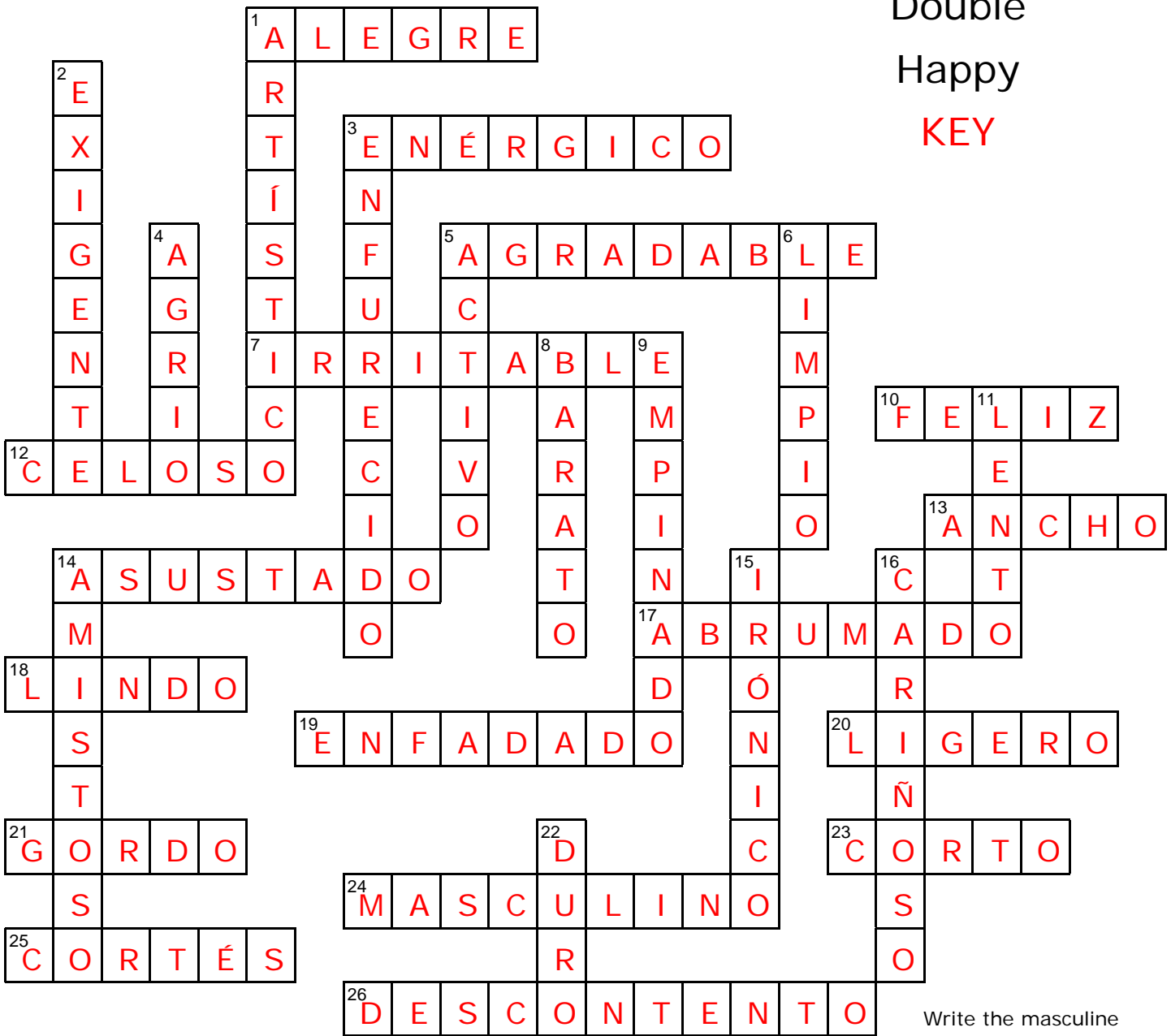
